



## APWA STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Genesee Valley Branch of the American Public Works Association (APWA) seeks to encourage students to consider a career in Civil Engineering, Urban/Regional Planning or in the Public Works Profession/Trade by providing partial financial support for tuition and fees to a student who has and/or will be enrolling into an accredited College or University or an accredited Trade School Training/Apprenticeship Program. APWA will award three (3) scholarship(s) annually in the amount of \$1,000 USD to the successful Applicant(s) to be applied to educational expenses during the **2022-2023** academic year.

### Eligibility

At the start of the **2022-2023** academic school year, Applicant(s) must provide proof of any of the following enrollment types:

1. A current full-time college student enrolled in a college or university accredited degree program in Civil Engineering, Urban or Regional Planning, or Public Works related field.
2. A High School senior accepted and enrolled into an accredited degree program in Civil Engineering, Urban or Regional Planning or Public Works related field.
3. A High School senior enrolled in an accredited educational Trade/Apprenticeship Program in an area applicable to Public Works (Construction Technology, Plumbing, Diesel or Automotive Technology, etc.).

**(Please Note: This Award will be issued annually to the student(s) that best meet the established scholarship criteria. Students may be awarded a scholarship over consecutive years, however, prior winners must re-apply annually for Award).**

### Selection Criteria

Eligible Applicants will be evaluated primarily on the basis of the information provided as part of this application. In addition to the Scholarship Application, the Candidate must submit the following applicable information:

- A. Current official College Transcript on official College letterhead.
- B. A copy of the acceptance letter from an accredited College or University the Applicant will be attending in the 2020-2021 academic year.
- C. Proof of entry into an approved Trade School or Apprenticeship Program.
- D. A Personal Resume or Biography including:
  - a. **ANY** Prior or Previous Work Experience

- b. A list of extra-curricular activities, clubs, community service, or programs that may indicate applicants desire to continue in the area of Public Works.
- c. A short paragraph describing the Applicants Future Goals.
- d. A minimum of (3) Letters of References from College Professors, Employers, Neighbors or Friends (References from Family Members or Relatives will not be accepted).

### **How To Apply**

To apply for the APWA Scholarship Award, an eligible Applicant must complete the attached Application Form and submit it with the required selection criteria to **gvapwa@gmail.com** by **April 22, 2022**. Award notification will be made on or around **May 26, 2022**. The scholarship check will be presented to the award recipient prior to the start of the 2022-2023 academic year.
